



DRIVER EDUCATION CLASSES: SUMMER 2019

The Montachusett Regional Vocational Technical School District Driver Education Program will run some additional courses this school year.

Important Notes for Driver Education Eligibility:

- The student must be 15 years and 9 months old on the first day of class.
- In order to participate, students must be in good academic standing. This means the student may not receive two "failing grades" in academics or fail his/her trade for any marking quarter. If a student is declared ineligible due to a failing grade(s) for a quarter, he/she may not participate in Driver Ed. until acceptable grades are verified by the student's next report card.

Program Costs and Time Limits:

The total cost of the course is **\$600**. A deposit of **\$300** is required to sign up and reserve a spot in the program. The remaining balance of **\$300** is due before starting drive time. Each student will be required to complete 12 hours of behind the wheel drive time and 6 hours of observation time with a licensed instructor (18 hours total). The student is also required to complete 30 classroom hours with a licensed instructor and successfully pass the final exam. Each student must complete the entire Driver Education curriculum, both classroom and behind the wheel instruction, within 2-years from the start of the first session in a Driver Education Program in order to obtain a Driver Education certificate of completion. This is the responsibility of the student and parent/guardian.

- **NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO SIGN UP FOR DRIVE TIME UNTIL THE TOTAL FEE IS PAID.**

Parental Responsibilities:

Parents are required by the RMV to take a mandatory 2-hour classroom session before the student is allowed to complete their on-road instruction and receive their Driver Education certificate of completion. If a parent has taken this class within the last five years, it is only necessary to produce the Certificate of Parental Curriculum Completion. A deposit must be paid and a spot in a class reserved for a student in order to attend a parent meeting. Students are NOT required to attend parent classes.

- **YOU CANNOT SIGN UP FOR DRIVER EDUCATION AT THE PARENT CLASS.**

Payment Options:

All payments must be made through the Monty Tech business office. Checks may be made payable to "**Monty Tech**". Please indicate the student's name on the memo line of the check. Payments by money order, cash, Visa and MasterCard are also accepted. There is also a \$50.00 fee for the use of the Driver Ed. vehicle for road tests, which must be paid prior to scheduling the exam at the RMV.

Notes:

- No refunds will be made once the Driver Education course begins
- Sign-ups are first-come-first-served. There are no waiting lists.
- The parent class will be held in the **MOUNTAIN ROOM**

Class Schedule:

Student classes will meet in the Monty Tech Mountain Room restaurant. Transportation to and from the program will be the responsibility of the student and family.

Driving:

Behind the wheel training will be scheduled on an individual basis with the instructors once classroom instruction has begun and the student has completed the following three obligations:

1. The student must have a valid learner's permit issued by the Registry of Motor Vehicles. This can be accomplished by having the student take and successfully pass a written learner's permit test at the Registry of Motor Vehicles.
2. The student must return a Parent/Guardian Permission Letter signed by the parent/guardian.
3. The student must pay the course fee in full.
