Montachusett Regional Vocational Technical School agrees to provide privilege of parking a privately owned vehicle on school property to a registered student under the following regulations indicated below:

- Students must park in the designated MVP spaces. Students are not allowed to park
 vehicles in the front of the building or at the Early Child Care Facility. Students parking in
 undesignated areas will receive a parking citation and be responsible for all towing
 expenses.
- Any MVP student who drives to school and needs to be dismissed should bring a signed note from a parent or guardian which approves the dismissal to the MVP Program Manager. On the day of the dismissal <u>only</u>, the student will be allowed to park at MVP Academy, thus facilitating the dismissal. As with all attendance-related issues, excessive dismissals <u>will</u> result in consequences including loss of parking privileges.
- The parking permit must be hung on the rearview mirror and visible at all times. If the student drives a different car to school then the MVP Program Manager must be notified and the parking tag must be displayed.
- Students assigned a parking permit are responsible for following all Monty Tech school rules & regulations and traffic laws in the Transportation section of the MVP Handbook at all times. Students must wear a seatbelt, drive slowly and safely on school property, must not exceed the speed limit (10MPH), are prohibited from using their cell phones while driving and must obey the directions of the parking monitors. Students are responsible for their passengers.
- You will have to stop to let buses in/out during arrival and departure. Leaving through the one-way entrance is prohibited.

- Any student who uses their vehicle to leave school grounds and/or transports other students during the school day without permission <u>will</u> have their permit suspended/revoked.
- Failure to follow school rules will result in parking privileges being suspended/revoked.
- Permits will be suspended/revoked at the discretion of the MVP Program Manager for excessive behavioral and attendance violations (including, but not limited to suspensions, more than five (5) attendance related issues - absences, tardies or dismissals unexcused), and/or any drug or alcohol infractions).
- Parking permits expire at the end of the school year. They are non-transferrable and may not be shared, borrowed, or purchased from another student.
- This agreement may be amended at any time by the MVP Program Manager and/or Monty Tech's school administration. In the event that changes are made, students and their parents/guardians will be notified via email and changes shall immediately become part of this agreement.
- This contract must be submitted along with a copy of the student's driver's license,
 registration(s), and \$25 Non-Refundable Fee Cash or Check (made out to Monty Tech)
