Discussion on Nexcamp solar contract. Two issues raised by legal council were the length of the contract and termination rights in the event the school was moved to different location. Joe Fiori responded to these concerns. 20 years is the standard contract that 2/3 of the public entities entered into the state of MA. Because of the possibility of a relocation by Monty Tech they did provide flexibility in that area as well as a one year termination notice. The mechanics of the operation are the same regardless of new technology; therefore, school savings would remain the same regardless of technology. The estimate is \$50,000 the first year with increases over time.

MOTION to endorse and put forward to the full school committee the Nexcamp Purchase and Sale Agreement as amended through discussions at this meeting by Brian Walker. Seconded by Jim Boone.

VOTE: 5 – 0 unanimous

Ms. Crockett had nothing to report on the FY21 budget status. The rumor is that state hopes to have numbers by the second week in August but no promises.
